## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. ORGANISAING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority (OA) is The Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club, 16 Mitala St, Newport 2106 in conjunction with the Jubilee One Design Association.

### 2. RULES

- 2.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS):
- 2.2 Boats must comply with the current Australian Sailing Special Regulations equipment requirements for Category 7.
- 2.3 All competing boats shall carry a functional hand held or cockpit mounted VHF radio for both safety purposes and Race Committee communication on VHF Channel 72.
- 2.4 Where there is conflict with the Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI) shall prevail except that neither shall change nor alter any Class Rules.
- 2.5 The regatta shall be a wet series and all boats shall be in the water at RPAYC by 0900hrs Friday 8 February 2019.

### 3. ALTERATION TO RACING RULES

- 3.1 The RRS will be modified in accordance with RRS 86 as follows:
  - a) Race Signals AP is amended in that, when displayed ashore, Code Flag "AP" with two sound signals (one when lowered) means the race is postponed. The Warning Signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after "AP" is lowered.
  - b) The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 or RRS 31 shall be a One Turn Penalty (one tack and one gybe in the same direction). This changes RRS 44.1 and 44.2.
  - c) Jubilee Class Rule 2 "Other Racing Rules" shall not apply.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all Jubilee One Design Class boats with a valid measurement and weight certificate. Refer to clause 7. Each boat may be weighted prior to the series.
- 4.2 All skippers and crew shall be financial members of a sailing club affiliated with a State Yachting Authority and Australian Sailing (Refer RRS 46) & their class association.
- 4.3 Eligible boats shall enter online: <http://www.rpayc.com.au/yacht-racing/regatta-and-championships> , which must be submitted with The Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club by Tuesday 5 February 2019 and be accompanied by the required fees \$330 inc GST (An additional late fee of \$50 shall apply thereafter), the Jubilee One Design Class Measurement Certificate and copy of a current AS Special Regulations Compliance Audit Form, Category 7.

## **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions shall be available to entrants by 1200hrs Thursday 7 February at the latest and published on the RPAYC website.

## **7. MEASUREMENT & COMPLIANCE**

- 7.1 Full measurement is not required, but all boats must conform to their class rules. The Race Committee reserves the right to inspect any boat prior to or during the regatta to establish whether or not the boat complies with the appropriate measurement restrictions.
- 7.2 Jubilee class boats shall present for registration at The Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club between 1200hrs and 1700hrs Thursday 7 February or between 0900hrs and 1000hrs on Friday 8 February.
- 7.3 The Race Committee reserves the right to measure and weigh any boat at any time throughout the regatta.

## **8. RACING AREA**

- 8.1 The races will be conducted on the waters of Pittwater, NSW.

## **9. COURSES:**

- 9.1 Courses to be sailed shall be windward / leeward courses as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

## **10. SCORING:**

- 10.1 A maximum of nine (9) races may be sailed. Five (5) races shall constitute a series.
- 10.2 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3 When six (6) or more races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **11. BERTHING**

- 11.1 Boats competing in the regatta shall be berthed free of charge at RPAYC from 0900hrs Thursday 7 February until Monday 11 February 2019. Berthing enquires should be directed to RPAYC **Waterfront** on **02 9998 3700** or [waterfront@rpayc.com.au](mailto:waterfront@rpayc.com.au) . Boats requiring berthing outside of this period shall contact the RPAYC Waterfront to make arrangements.
- 11.2 Launch and recovery – boats can be launched and recovered through Crystal Bay. For assistance in launching boats please contact to RPAYC **Waterfront** on **02 9998 3700** ~~or David Bray on~~

## **12. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

- 12.1 All boats shall be afloat before 0900hrs on Friday 8 February 2019 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with, and according to the terms of, prior written permission of the Race Committee.

## **13. PRIZES:**

- 13.1 The Huntingfield Cup shall be awarded to the winner of the Australian Championship.  
The Les Pound Trophy shall be awarded to the first Victorian boat.  
The Victorian JYA Trophy shall be awarded to the first New South Wales Boat  
The Charles Peel Trophy shall be awarded to the winner of the final race.  
The highest place boat helmed by a female shall be awarded a trophy.
- 13.2 Individual trophies may be awarded to each boat placing first, second and third in the Championship.
- 13.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.

## **14. INSURANCE**

- 14.1 Each participating boat must be insured with current third party property insurance cover and valid third-party personal liability insurance cover of not less than AU\$10,000,000 (10 million dollars) or equivalent thereof in any other currency for any one claim event.

## **15. MEDIA AND IMAGE RIGHTS WAIVER**

- 15.1 By entering this regatta, the owner (or charterer) and crew members on competing boats grant at no cost the absolute right and permission to use their names, voices, images, likenesses, and biographical material, as well as representations of their boat in any media (including television, print and internet), to the Organising Authority.
- 15.2 Competitors and crew members' name, voice, image, likeness and biographical material shall not be used by the Organising Authority, Host Club, or any event sponsors in a way which constitutes an endorsement of sponsors' products by said competitors and crew members, unless the relevant competitor or crew member is engaged by the sponsor to endorse said products or gives his/her prior written consent to such use.

15.3 By participating in this regatta Owners (charterers) and crew members shall acknowledge and accept the granting of media rights referred to in this paragraph 15.

**16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

16.1 It is the competitor's decision to enter the Event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the Event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in the Event competitors must indemnify the Organising Authority their officers, members, staff and agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the Event.

16.2 The Organising Authority their officers, members, staff and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the Event or howsoever arising in connection with the Event.

16.3 Competitors' attention is drawn to RRS 4 – Decision to Race.
